1. Apologies

2. Public forum

2 recent incidents at Franklands Corner discussed. Alison gave details of site meeting there in December 2015 and that she has kept a spreadsheet of non-injury incidents since then to monitor situation.

3. Response to article in December/January News & Views and public views

Only issues that have been identified to Alison are Franklands Corner and parking outside the school.

4. Issues/ideas to take forward

Yellow backed signs for 30mph at entry points and repeater signs through village
Franklands Corner
Parking outside school
See if SID data supports perception that vehicles speeding through village.

5. Next steps

Alison to find out ball-park figures for:

1. Franklands Corner – take out centre line, put in edge white lines, 2 extra signs and ?red tarmac/signs on road
2. Yellow backing on 30mph signs both ends of village
3. Yellow backing on repeater signs
4. Redo/extend zig-zag lines outside school.

Alison to ask Balfour Beatty for SID data asap.

Freight strategy document completed – Alison to circulate to PC before submitting.

Noted that cement lorry comes from Haywoods Lane, Orchard Green, down Woodbine and reverse to quarry – may be resident in Springfield Close, agreed should be asked not to use Woodbine as unsuitable for HGVs and causing problems.

6. News & Views copy for February copy date (20.1.17)

Agreed Robin and Alison will write copy with issues so far and possible work and ask for feedback from parishioners about what other issues are important. – cannot justify spending precept or negotiating funding from developers on response so far.
